As a result of these meetings, Bill Clemons has been retained to represent us. He has been in regular communication with the Attorney General's office regarding this matter. He has also filed a motion and complaint on behalf of the POA Board, which represents the property owners, to intervene in this case. Intervening provides us with the opportunity to offer ideas and interface with DEQ, the authority who decides the near-term fate of our dam. (motion and complaint available at link below)
