Breach Plan Submitted and Rejected; RWLC Attorney Inquires on Impact to Consent Judgement

On April 10th, Schnabel Engineering, the engineer of record for the dam remediation, submitted the plans to breach the dam to DEMLR on behalf of WLCCC, meeting the deadline set by the Consent Judgement (CJ). This plan was subsequently rejected by DEMLR on April 12th. After a review of the submittal, DEMLR determined that the plan was not approvable and did not meet the requirements. Bill Clemmons, the RWLC attorney, sent an inquiry to the Attorney General asking what rejection of the plan means to the CJ. Since the CJ called for an approvable plan which was not delivered, rejection could mean WLCCC is not in compliance with the order. At the time of writing, Bill has not received a response from the AG's office.
