## **A refresher on our class-action lawsuit:**

The class-action lawsuit was filed on behalf of Woodlake property owners in the Moore County Superior Court on the 23rd of October. The defendants (WLCCC) failed to respond to the lawsuit within the required time period.

## **Today's Court Hearing outcome**

Today (01/19/18), our lawyers presented a motion to the Moore County Superior Court, the Honorable Judge James M. Webb presiding, to certify a Class consisting of all property owners within Woodlake. No one representing WLCCC appeared at the hearing.

**The Property Owner Class was preliminarily certified**, and the notice to all Class members approved. That notice will explain who is in the Class, the potential outcome of a judgment, and how to opt-out of the Class. The notice will be sent via USPS to all Class members next week. The law firm of Jordan Price, which has been representing us since the beginning of the lawsuit, was approved to represent the certified Property Owner Class, with Hope Derby Carmichael as the lead attorney.

## **The Next Court Hearing:**

The next court hearing, scheduled for March 22, will again be in the Moore County Superior Court, with Judge Webb presiding. This hearing will be to define and support the suit's claimed damages to the members of the Property Owner Class and to rule on our Motion for Default Judgment.
